

Openings on the QLD NT PNG ARMS Chapter Committee

Call for nominations for new members on the committee

ARMS is a voluntary society that aims to enhance professional development and professional networks for its members, and is formed of state-based chapters. The QLD NT PNG Chapter has approximately 550 members, many of whom are part of an institutional membership at universities, research institutes or other agencies.

The QLD NT PNG Chapter Committee has openings for all committee member positions, including the Convenor, Secretary, Treasurer and General Members.

The term of a committee member is two years for no more than two consecutive terms (i.e. up to four years in total).

The Chapter Committee offers a chance to engage with like-minded colleagues from other parts of the research management sector, build networks and to help the Chapter host occasional events to build skills and engagement within the other ARMS members. There are also opportunities to contribute more broadly across the Society through the Member Services Committee.

How to nominate

If you would like to grow your professional networks and develop your professional skills, please self-nominate by completing the attached nomination form and emailing it to arms_qld_nt_png@researchmanagement.org.au by **Friday 19 June 2020**.

Officer elections will occur at the annual general meeting in late-June (further details to be provided). If the number of nominations received equals the number of vacancies to be filled, the persons nominated shall be deemed elected. If insufficient nominations are received to fill all vacancies, further nominations may be received at the annual general meeting. If the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, voting will occur by a (virtual) show of hands.

A committee member is expected to:

- Attend all meetings;
- Contribute in a meaningful way to Chapter discussions and event planning;
- Actively participate in ARMS Chapter and/or national events;
- Provide suggestions and help with the coordination and planning of Chapter events, particularly with securing speakers and venues, developing flyers, organising catering etc;
- Promote ARMS within their individual organization and beyond as they have the opportunity;
- Report back to the Chapter on new ideas and thoughts for future events or ideas that will benefit the QLD NT PNG membership.
